Greetings dear family and friends,

Meet the Kamono-Kafe translation team who are hard at work on their Old Testament after finishing a revision of the New Testament in 2014. They meet 3 times weekly to work all day, and I assist as their “English dictionary” on Wednesdays, being sure key concepts and words are included in the translation. These guys are all husbands and fathers, and have pastoral duties in their local churches.

They also run a coffee roasting and packaging business to supplement the cost of Bible translation.



They buy coffee beans from the smaller farmers in the area who must compete with the much larger coffee plantations in the mountains of PNG.



Also meet Franky who distributes the Bibles, literature, SD cards for playing the Bible on phones, and audio-Bible devices. Here he is putting together kits for school kids which they can buy for a dollar, containing some school supplies and Bible tracts and a primer in the Kamono-Kafe language. He travels by motorcycle on some crazy terrain to reach many villages in the area.

The SALT (Scripture Application and Leadership Training) team just returned from teaching a 2-week course in a remote area for the Kasua language group.



We are thrilled to hear the outcome of this course, with over 70 lives dedicated to Christ. There was much singing and thanking the Lord together as we shared a meal in celebration at my house.
