even as He continually looks after us! He lives always to interceed for us! (Heb 7:25)


Evidences of His Advocacy

I wrote my last report in November with a number of things to bring to the Father. In this report, I want to share how our Advocate has been diligently working on our behalf and answering those prayers (that I know about):

I. Larry, visionary for the stalled Indo1000 project, reports that the administrative blockage has been resolved – he has resigned from the org he formerly directed, and he is joining with other partners and getting on with things. He said that he recently had a great trip to the central island of Sulawesi (circled on the map) where they were declared to be God's answer to the prayers of a really dynamic 'insider' Church movement touching most of the languages which need local language Bible resources because they have none! Imagine trying to grow in Christ with no Bible in your language! Continue to pray for Larry as he partners with YWAM and Teen Missions in Indonesia to train and send out many "young apostles" who will introduce the Story app to these hungry tribal communities. And thank God for Zach (PBT) and his team who have completed all the Story app resources into Bahasa Indonesian!

3. We **asked the Lord to redeem my car crash situation**. Over the last 2 months, he has done that: my whiplash injuries are now healed; I learned about and am adjusting to a healthier eating



protocol; I am able to play vigorous pickleball several hours a week; a car body repairman bought the wrecked car which will end up being a nice vehicle for his wife; mechanic friends helped me to find and fix up "Big Red" which will be a less



expensive car for my Mom and me to maintain. (It being red was partly how the Lord guided us to know which car to get.) The Lord

also used this crisis to surface some sensitive issues between my Mom and me and He is helping us to sort them out.

4. You have been praying for **perseverance and discernment in drafting exegetical resources** for the Honey Bee (HB) oral translation app. We are currently working on **Matthew** now because folks in Brazil want to field test HB in a few months, and that is the book they need to translate. I was struggling mentally and emotionally (i.e. procrastinating) with the mind-bending work and tedium of the task. But **our Advocate has obviously been helping me.** I am enjoying the work more, and He helped

An oral Bible translation workflow app with embedded exegetical helps for local language translators me to find a free AI text-to-speech tool with which to auduio-ize the finalized drafts. On top of that, because we are developing cuttingedge translation tools designed for remote local translators, I was very



encouraged to be invited to attend a (selective) translation conference, hosted by YWAM Brazil, to take place early March just outside of São Paulo. Pray for me as I organize the logistics to go (e.g. purchase tickets, get a visa, sort out arrangements for Mom while I'm gone). This is a tremendous opportunity to raise awareness for these apps and network with other leaders involved with innovating for the Bibleless and unreached. And, it is yet another indication how the Lord is in the process of answering prayers began about ten years ago: Lord, raise up an army of young people (e.g. YWAMers) who will take these mobile, off-grid translation tools to the last remote

unreached and Bibleless communities and help them get started in translating and publishing the Life-giving Word for themselves and their people.

5. We've been praying for the translation teams in India. Prem and Angel are healing from the loss of their baby. Many of the local teams are continuing to translate and publish Bible videos for their people. I'm sure only heaven will reveal all the salvation and growing-in-grace stories spawned from God's story going forth in understandable languages. And! Completely unexpectedly, the Lord put me in contact with Paul (IMB) and Raman who have been working for years to revise the out-of-date Hindi Bible translation which is the primary Word source that so many in India use. They are very interested to make their updated easy-to-understand Hindi translation available via the Honey Bee software to enable and empower local language translators there. I love that! Pray for Paul and Raman in this work – to be encouraged and also that the Lord will add gifted translators to their team. (They lost two translators in recent years.)
